Our design moved the sink under the window, and reduced the depth of the cabinets that were used for display. This gave a precious couple of square feet to the open floor space. Lastly, our clients had an abundance of beautiful glassware and pottery and they wanted to give their collection a home. The design exceeded our client's expectations!

Materials and Finishes Used:

- **Cabinetry:** Omega Custom and Omega/Dynasty semi custom cabinetry
- **Door style:** Williamsburg
- **Wood:** Maple **Stain:** - Natural
- **Moldings:** Alder with Mandarin
- **Granite Countertops:** Baltic Brown
- **Sink:** Blanco Siligranit Double Bowl **Color:** Anthracite
- **Faucet:** Belle Foret, Oil Rubbed Bronze
- **Cabinet hardware:** Twisted wire knobs in Oil Rubbed Bronze finish
- **Lighting:** Interior and under cabinet lighting, recessed lighting
- **Ceramic Tile Flooring:** Shaw - Jakarta
- **Backsplash Tile:** Jakarta CS with 6x6 granite Baltic Brown insets.
- **Garbage disposal:** Mountain King
